

Food, Glorious Food!

English

Our English writing will be based on texts set or written in Victorian times. Our first text will be 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty, and we will use this book to explore stories with historical settings. We will also be looking at A Christmas Carol retold by Tony Mitton and adapting the story to create our own play scripts. For poetry, we will be looking at 'Twas the Night Before Christmas' and developing our oral performances.

Grammar & Punctuation – We will be looking at a range of punctuation for parenthesis, model verbs and adverbs, active and passive voice and speech punctuation.

<u>Guided Reading</u> – We will be using a variety of poetry, fiction and non-fiction texts to develop our inference and deduction skills.



Maths

We will be exploring Fractions (compare, order and equivalences). Multiplication and division (multiples, factors and prime numbers). Measurement (length and area). Time (12 and 24 hour time).








Science

We will be looking at 'Changes of materials' in Science this half term. This unit builds upon exploring materials, to consider how materials can be changed and adapted. This is presented in various ways, such as chemical and physical changes. Learners will discover more about the molecular structure of materials, in simple terms, and gain an understanding of changes that are reversible and irreversible.

Geography

Iln Geography, we will be looking at where different foods come from. This will give us the opportunity to locate different countries within Europe. South America and Africa. As part of our learning we will be exploring time zones, latitude and longitude, different biomes and climate zones, and the concept of food miles.



Design & Technology

In design and technology, we will be evaluating a range of food products and researching different methods and recipes. Our aim is to create our own different recipes for bread taking into account the properties of ingredients and sensory characteristics. We will then devise step by step plans which can be read/followed by someone else.

Art

In art, we will be looking at the work of Georgia O'Keeffe and April Coppini. We will be doing a number of observational drawings in their styles using different media.

PE

Our unit in PE is based on different invasion games. We will be having a go at tag rugby.

RE

The focus of our RE lessons this half term will be exploring loss. death and Christian hope.

Technola

We are going to be looking at robotics (computer science) with Technola in our ICT lessons this half term. Students will build advanced programs to convert robots into autonomous vehicles! They create code with multiple events and conditionals to tackle problems with unpredictable elements.
